

## NOTICE

This notice is given by Kevin B. Quinn, Jr., Administrator of the Maryland Department of Transportation Maryland Transit Administration (MDOT MTA), acting pursuant to the Proclamation of Governor Lawrence J. Hogan, Jr. (the “Governor”) dated March 5, 2020 proclaiming a state of emergency and a catastrophic health emergency related to COVID-19, as it may be amended or renewed from time to time, and the Order of the Governor dated March 12, 2020 entitled “Extending Certain Licenses, Permits, Registrations, and Other Governmental Authorizations, and Authorizing Suspension of Legal Time Requirements”, as it may be amended from time to time, after finding that the action(s) described herein will not endanger the public health, welfare, or safety.

Section 7-208(b-1)(2)(ii) of the Transportation Article of the Maryland Code requires MDOT MTA to increase fares every five years for MARC and Commuter Bus service as provided in the statute. The last rate change for MARC and Commuter Bus was implemented on June 25, 2015. The 2020 fare increase pursuant to the statute is hereby delayed. Any effect of section 7-208(b-1)(2)(ii) of the Transportation Article inconsistent with the foregoing is hereby suspended.

This Notice is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until 30 days after the state of emergency has been terminated and the proclamation of the catastrophic health emergency has been rescinded.
